Acadia's **Participaction Days** are scheduled for **Thursday, February 4 and Friday, February 5, 2010**. Once again we are offering a wide variety of activities for students over the course of these two days.

Student sign up for activities will take place at **8:00 a.m. in our school gym on the following days;**

- Grade 9 - Tuesday, December 8
- Grade 8 - Wednesday, December 9
- Grade 7 - Thursday, December 10
- Catch All - Friday, December 11

Students will need to come to school and put their names on the lists to reserve their spaces in the activities of their choice. Students must prepare three choices for each day of activities. Space in each activity is limited so arriving early in the morning to line up for their choices is important.

Parents are reminded that Participaction days are **regular school days** and students are expected to register for activities for both days. This is an important event that fosters positive relationships within our school and is devoted to expanding and nurturing the physical and social well-being of our students.

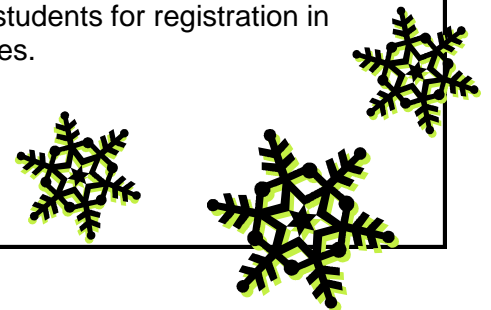
Should activities need to be cancelled due to low sign up students will be required to be flexible in signing up for alternative spaces.

- Students will stay in chalets similar to hotel rooms
- Students should bring their own lunches and snacks
- A canteen is available
- On Thursday attendance will be taken of students at 6:30 a.m. at Acadia
- The bus will depart Acadia promptly at 6:45 a.m.
- Students will be provided with dinner on Thursday night and breakfast on Friday morning
- The bus will return to Acadia at approximately 5:30 p.m. on Friday
- Cost is \$180 without rentals
- Cost is \$200 with ski rental
- Cost is \$216 with snowboard rental
- A **\$50 non-refundable deposit** is required for students to secure their spots in this activity. This deposit must be submitted to Mr. Grape.
- The January due date for the remaining monies for this activity will be set with students in an upcoming meeting
