- **MANITOBA BLUE CROSS BURSARY AWARD PROGRAM** - Manitoba Blue Cross is pleased to offer a Scholarship/Bursary Program to Manitoba students. This program is meant to serve as a reward for high scholastic achievement and as an incentive to encourage more students to seek the benefits of higher education. Eligible students must apply directly to the community college or university to be considered. A list of scholarship categories and participating facilities is available in the school office.
- **ORDER OF SONS OF ITALY SCHOLARSHIPS** - The Order of Sons of Italy Garibaldi Lodge of Manitoba will award tow \$1,000 scholarships for the 2008/2009 academic year. The scholarships are available to all Manitoba students of Italian background entering post-secondary university education. Applications can be obtained from Charles Sherbo by phoning 957-8332 (business) or 837-1584 (residence). Criteria for selection include:
 - Scholastic achievement
 - Community involvement, especially in the Italian community of Manitoba
 - Financial need
